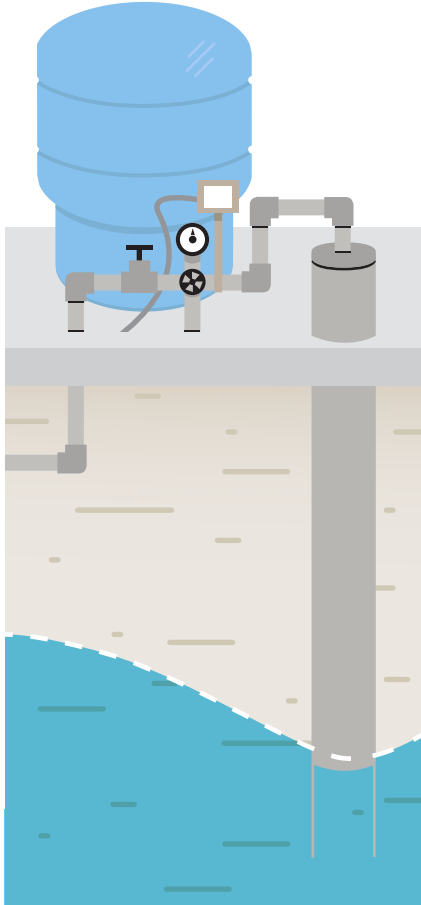

Groundwater Sustainability Workshop

Private well users on parcels under 5 acres are cordially invited to a public workshop and open house hosted by the North Kings Groundwater Sustainability Agency (NKGSA).



The workshop will cover:

- What is the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) and what does this new state law require for well owners?
- What are the current groundwater levels in the region, and could private wells be affected in the future?
- Share your ideas and recommendations for groundwater recharge and groundwater conservation.

The NKGSA is a local public agency formed in response to SGMA, a state law passed in 2014 requiring sustainable groundwater use by homes, farms, industries, and others in areas that are at-risk of overdraft. Your property is within the boundary of NKGSA. This open house is an opportunity to learn about groundwater and participate in the development of a Groundwater Sustainability Plan as required by SGMA.
